Behavior Contract

Our goal is to provide a fun, wholesome, educational theatrical experience for all. This requires an encouraging, respectful, and supportive attitude from all who are involved. Inappropriate, rude, or disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated and is grounds for dismissal. Please discuss this with your child.

Behavioral Guidelines

- Participation with CSP is a privilege and only cooperative behavior is allowed.
- Respect for the Directors, parents, volunteers, other students, and facility representatives is expected.
- Respectful language will be used. No name-calling or profanity is allowed.
- CSP expects students' conduct to be respectful to property. Therefore, any intentional or negligent damage done to property will be expected to be replaced or repaired by the student.
- CSP expects respect of one's own body; therefore, drugs, alcohol, and smoking are strictly prohibited.
- Overt physical contact of students is not allowed.
- CSP students are expected to dress appropriately and modestly.
- CSP wants all students to put forth their best effort.

Rehearsal and Performance Guidelines

- Avoid unnecessary noise and distractions during rehearsals and performances.
- Stay in designated areas. CSP students may not leave the facilities at any time during rehearsals or performances. (This includes breaks between class and rehearsals).
- A sack lunch/snack may be brought by the student at the beginning of class. A sack lunch may also be brought by an adult during rehearsal time.
- Rehearsal space and dressing rooms must be clean before ANY students are dismissed.
- Behave in a professional manner.
 - a. Attend all rehearsals and performances unless you are ill or have received the Director's permission.
 - b. Be on time and stay for the entire rehearsal. (Parents: please pick up your children on time, as well.)
 - c. Be prepared with personal costume items, makeup, scripts, pencils, and appropriate dance shoes.
- Have a great time learning and growing!

Consequences

1. Adult in charge will talk with the individual student about his/her misbehavior.
2. The student will be removed from rehearsal.
3. Adult in charge will call the parent and explain the misbehavior of the student.
4. Parent will be asked to pick up the student.
 - Depending on the severity of the offense, dismissal from the show may result.
